# Hi Music Exhibition Set Tuesday

A high-fidelity music demonstration by a nationally-known sound engineer will be held Tuesday evening at Watsonville high school.

Paul Klipsch, inventor of the "Klipschorn" loudspeaker system, will demonstrate reproduction of musical sounds from tape and records. The session is open to the public without charge; it is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. Tuesday in the high school's room 201. Dr. Ralph Kent of the high school music department and Leonard Marr, a college classmate of Klipsch, have arranged the demonstration. Marr is with the US soil conservation service here.

Klipsch, 52, is an engineer who holds a number of patents in acoustics, ordnance and geophysics. He settled in Hope, Ark., in 1946, where he owns and operates the factory manufacturing his speaker equipment.
